Correct Responses:

- Door 1 is keyed AA1 and the receptionist receives key AA1.
- Sales (Door8) is keyed AA2 and the sales personnel receive key AAX1 . (This key is a first level master which passes the AA1 – AA4.)
- Account (Door 5) is keyed AA9 and the Accounting personnel receive the AAY1 key. (The AA5 key is uncuttable. The AAY1 key is a first level master which passes the AA1, AA5, AA9 and the AAA13. It will not pass the AA2.)
- Check Print Room (Door 6) is keyed AB9 (the page below the AA9) and the HD. Acct receives the AWY1 key. (The AWY1 is a second level master and passes all the keys that the Y1 passes on all four pages above it.)
- The Exec. Wing is keyed to the AA17 key and they receive the AAZ1 key. (The AAZ1 key is a first level master and passes the AA1, AA17, AA33 and AA49.)
- The President carries the GMK and his door is keyed to the AB17 in case the Exec. Sec needs access to the Presidents office. Then she would carry the AWZ1 key (instead) which is a second level master key and passes all the keys that the Z1 passes on all four pages above it.)
